Dear Parent(s)/Guardian(s):

The recent notice from Option C and the Health Department (about another positive case) has us preparing for another Quarantine. Mindful of the re-adjustment, yet again, we are very aware that personal safety comes first. The game plan for the beginning of the quarantine and the next two weeks, until Monday, February 22<sup>nd</sup>, when we return on-site, will be as follows:

- 1) Monday, February 8<sup>th</sup> – This will be our pick-up and re-organizational day for students and staff. Teachers will be on-site to monitor the picking up of books in their homerooms by the students (unless they are already quarantined in which case their homerooms will be covered.) **We ask that the students bring an empty, sturdy school bag to facilitate the pick-ups.** Teachers will also be monitoring the usual entrances: gym, side door behind the Church, Kindergarten entrance on Kipling Lane, and the PreK modulars. Parents/Guardians will wait outside, as usual, for the students to return. The schedule to do so is as follows: (If the times are not convenient you may stop by from 11:30 to 12:30 or 2:30 to 3:00.)

 9:30 to 10:30 D to J  
 10:30 to 11:30 K to M  
 12:30 to 1:30 N to S  
 1:30 to 2:30 T to Z

- 2) Tuesday, February 9<sup>th</sup> – Classes begin virtually, with non-quarantined teachers on site. Continue to follow the daily announcements on the school website for any updates. The February letter will be on hold until we can solidify necessary calendar adjustments. We have been given an extended yearbook deadline which will allow us to incorporate the school pictures that have yet to be taken. Your prayerful and consistent encouragement are valued more than you know. 2021 is not what we bargained for but as Faith-filled people, “We know not what tomorrow brings, but we know Who brings tomorrow.” We will get through this!
